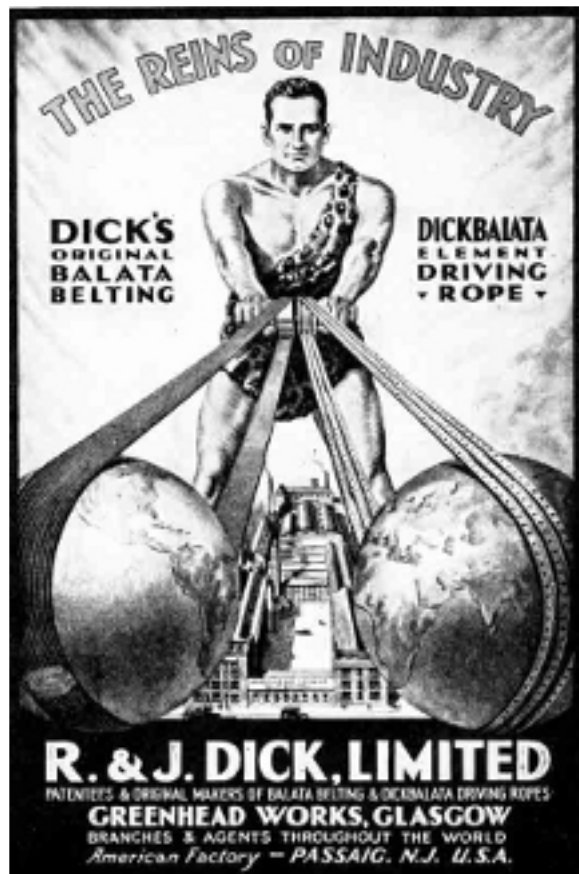
Darlington Area Shops Hit by Mysterious Chain Shortage
